Camera Policy

In the interest of protecting children using the Leisure Centre facilities, the use of camera and video equipment will now be regulated as from 1st June 2006 following the new Amateur Swimming Association and NSPCC guidelines.

Anyone wishing to use a camera or video equipment during any session including swimming parties must leave their details at reception at the beginning of the session and provide **photographic proof of identity** to the Duty Manager. The Duty Manager will then issue each person with a Camera and Video Equipment Pass which must be returned at the end of the session (£1 returnable deposit required). It must also be understood that photography is only permitted if there are no objections from other customers.

The use of camera or video equipment on poolside is allowed as long as all children are in the pool or are wearing a t-shirt and shorts.

Those found using a camera without gaining permission may be asked to leave the building.

The use of any cameras in the changing areas is **strictly prohibited**.

The use of camera phones is **strictly prohibited** anywhere in the centre.
